### **Origami Frogs**

### **Name Cartouche**

Print each child with a cartouche template printed on card, and a sheet of alphabet symbols (see templates). The child cuts out and sticks on his/her name from the alphabet, and decorates as wished.

### **Make What You Can**

Junk modelling - create what you like from junk such as cardboard boxes & tubes, plastic tubs & pots, straws, buttons, lids, foil, fabric, feathers, etc.

You will also need to provide paints & brushes, glue & glue sticks and sellotape.

### **Pitta Pockets & Wacky Wraps**

Fill pitta breads or wraps with e.g. grated cheese, chopped ham, sliced cucumber, sliced tomato, sliced grapes, grated/sliced apple, salad cream, jam, etc.
