Leader:

Jonah was born in Gath Hopher, 3 or 4 miles north of Nazareth, in Galilee. From there, in disobedience to God, he fled to Joppa. And from there, eventually, he

found himself in Nineveh, taking God's word to the hated Assyrians: occupiers and enemies of Israel.

Seven hundred years later, another man from Galilee travelled to Joppa - but Simon Peter travelled in obedience to God. From there, he found himself in Caesarea, taking God's word to the hated Romans: Gentile occupiers and enemies of Israel.
